Thank you for inquiring about participating in the first annual Cambridge Main Street Christmas Parade Pageant. The Cambridge Christmas Parade is an annual holiday tradition and we are excited to add to this year's event.

The pageant is being held as a fundraiser for both Cambridge Main Street, a nonprofit dedicated to the historic preservation and economic development of downtown Cambridge and the Freedom House, a warming/homeless shelter serving the citizens of Guernsey County.

Six (6) local youth will get the opportunity to reign over the Cambridge Christmas Parade, Saturday evening, November 28th as the Queen and King, Prince and Princess and the Little Mr. and Miss. Winners will be awarded prizes such as crowns, sashes, flowers, and trophies and will have the opportunity to ride in the Cambridge Christmas Parade.

Age groups will consist off **Little Mr. and Miss (2-6 years), Princess/Prince (7-12 years) and Queen/King (13-18 years).**

Each contestant will raise money by placing up to three (3) cans in and around Cambridge from October 10 -Nov 13. One can **MUST** be in a downtown merchant. Cans **MUST** display the attached artwork and have the contestant's photograph on the outside. Recipients are responsible for can placement including contacting the businesses asking permission to place the cans. All monies **MUST** be turned in to either the Cambridge Main Street office or at the Cambridge/Guernsey County Convention & Visitors Bureau office by 4pm on November 13. Contestants are encouraged to turn in monies throughout the entry times, but are not required. Monies can be dropped off Mon-Fri from 8am-4pm at the Cambridge/Guernsey County Convention & Visitors Bureau or Cambridge Main Street office from Oct. 10-Nov. 13. The contestant raising the most money in each category at the end of the time allotted will be crowned the winner. Crowning will take place Saturday , November 21 at 1pm at the Cambridge Performing Arts Centre. Please dress appropriately for crowning.

CAMBRIDGE MAIN STREET CHRISTMAS PARADE PAGEANT
RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.) All candidates are considered representatives of the City of Cambridge, Cambridge Main Street and of the Cambridge Christmas Parade. Proper, positive appearance and conduct are expected at all times.
- 2.) Contestants do not have to reside in Cambridge but must reside in Guernsey County.
- 3.) Contestants names and photographs will be displayed before, during and after the parade in print, on our website and social media platforms.
- 4.) Selection of royalty will be solely based on the amount of money raised by each candidate. In the event of a tie, both contestants will share the title.
- 5.) Contestants who are caught cheating (ie setting out additional cans, removing or covering up competition cans, etc) will result in forfeiture of any prizes won.
- 6.) Age of candidates is based on their age as of the day of the Cambridge Christmas Parade which is Saturday, November 28. So for example if your child turns 7 on Sunday, November 28 they will be competing in the 2-6 year old category.
- 7.) If any of the winners are unable to participate in the parade, the first runner up will be awarded the title.
- 8.) High standards of conduct are expected of all contestants. The use of nicotine, drugs or alcohol and or the use of profanity shall result in the disqualification from the competition and or/loss of title.
- 9.) All royalty must remain poised, smiling, attentive and waving to the crowd throughout the entire parade.
- 10.) All entrants, outside of the winner(s) selected may enter future Cambridge Christmas Parade Pageants.
- 11.) Participants must disclose the location of the (3) cans they have placed. Entrants placing more than 3 cans WILL be disqualified.

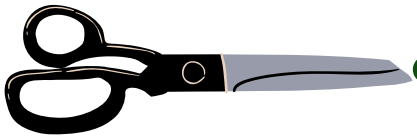
All decisions made by the Board of Directors of Cambridge Main Street are final.
